MEMBERSHIP CATEGORIES

Builder Member

Includes single-family builders, multi-family builders, remodelers, general contractors, land developers. Compliance with the BIA Professional Standards and BIA Ethics Policy is a condition of membership. Builders' dues are based upon gross dollar volume of sales for preceding year.

Associate Member

Any individual who is engaged in, or employed by a firm or corporation engaged in a trade, industry, or profession related to the building industry and does not qualify as a builder member. One person may hold both a builder and an associate membership, providing the person qualifies in each category and meets all obligations of membership.

Affiliate Member

Additional employee of a current builder or associate member. Affiliate members enjoy the full rights and privileges of membership providing they meet all obligations of membership, but cannot serve on the Board of Trustees.

MEMBERSHIP PROCESS

Criteria for Active Builder Membership

- 1. Applicant shall read, sign and abide by the BIA Ethics Policy.
- 2. Application for builder/remodeler/land developer membership must be accompanied by the names of references from:
 - a. An Active member of the BIA of Central Ohio.
 - A homeowner/customer/lot purchaser on a completed project within the last two years (cannot be family, employees or principals of the company applying for membership).
 - c. A material supplier who is a member of the BIA of Central Ohio or an affiliate Home Builders Association.
 - d. A trade partner who is a member of the BIA of Central Ohio or an affiliate Home Builders Association.
- 3. Applicants shall submit proof of insurance for the company applying for membership.
- 4. Applicants shall submit proof of workers compensation coverage on the company applying for membership.
- 5. After receipt of a completed application, the applicant's name will be posted on the BIA website for a comment period by the general membership for 30 days. During this time, applicant will be considered a contingent member. After the comment period, the application will be reviewed by the Board of Trustees for election to membership at the next scheduled Board meeting. During the 30-day comment period, applicant will not be considered a member, however the BIA reserves the right to permit applicants to participate in BIA events upon timely registration and payment for same and/or receive local benefits. Membership in the OHBA and NAHB will commence after the 30 day comment period pending Board approval.
- 6. If an Active member leaves the Association for any reason for a period of more than 4 months, that member must submit to the same approval process as a new Active member applicant.
- 7. If an Active member leaves the Association with a violation of the BIA Ethics Policy as determined by the BIA Board or violations of the Professional Standards as determined by the Professional Standards Committee, or with outstanding obligations to homeowners or prior financial obligations to the BIA, the Board of Trustees will determine if those obligations have been satisfied before that member is allowed to re-join the Association under the same or another company name.
- 8. If a builder member resigns from the BIA with unresolved complaints deemed to be legitimate by the Professional Standards Committee or the BIA Board, consideration of future reinstatement will be contingent upon a determination that the complaint or complaints were resolved to the reasonable satisfaction of the home owner or the Professional Standards Committee.
- 9. The Board of Trustees, in its sole discretion, on a case-by-case basis, may consider special circumstances to grant membership, including where a member's status may have changed due to any of the following: change of employment, a merger or acquisition, start of a new company, or the death of a member.

All other terms and conditions of membership as defined the Association's Bylaws shall still apply.

Criteria for Active Associate and Affiliate Membership

- 1. Applicant shall read, sign and abide by the BIA Ethics Policy.
- 2. After receipt of a completed application, the applicant's name will be posted on the BIA website for a comment period by the general membership for 30 days. During this time, applicant will be considered a contingent member. After the comment period, the application will be reviewed by the Board of Trustees for election to membership at the next scheduled Board meeting. During the 30-day comment period, applicant will not be considered a member, however the BIA reserves the right to permit applicants to participate in BIA events upon timely registration and payment for same and/or receive local benefits. Membership in the OHBA and NAHB will commence after the 30 day comment period pending Board approval.
- 3. If an Active member leaves the Association for any reason for a period of more than 4 months, that member must submit to the same approval process as a new Active member applicant.
- 4. If an Active member leaves the Association with a violation of the BIA Ethics Policy, as determined by the BIA Board, which may include obligations to homeowners or outstanding financial obligations to the BIA, the Board of Trustees will determine if those obligations have been satisfied before that member is allowed to re-join the Association under the same or another company name.
- 5. If Active member resigns from the BIA with unresolved complaints deemed to be legitimate by the Board of Trustees, consideration of future reinstatement will be contingent upon a determination that the complaint or complaints were resolved to the reasonable satisfaction of the Board of Trustees.
- 6. The Board of Trustees, in its sole discretion, on a case-by-case basis, may consider special circumstances to grant membership, including where a member's status may have changed due to any of the following: change of employment, a merger or acquisition, start of a new company, or the death of a member.

All other terms and conditions of membership as defined the Association's Bylaws shall still apply.

 practices that may result in deliberate undermining of another member's qualifications or reputation for honesty, stability or integrity.
- Members assume these responsibilities freely and solemnly, mindful that they are part of our obligation as members of the Building Industry Association of Central Ohio.
