## Shuttle Service

Airport Shuttle New Orleans departs from each baggage claim area every 30-minutes and services multiple stops through the Central Business District of New Orleans (which includes the New Orleans Marriott). Prices average \$20.00 per person, one-way, or \$38 per person, round-trip. You can pre-purchase shuttle tickets and find more information by clicking here; prices may vary and are subject to change.

## Taxi Cabs

Estimated taxi fares are \$33 from Louis Armstrong New Orleans International Airport (MSY) to the New Orleans Marriott; prices may vary and are subject to change.

#### **DRIVING DIRECTIONS - BY CAR**

The New Orleans Marriott is located about 13 miles South East of Louis Armstrong New Orleans International Airport, and is approximately 30 minutes by car.

Once you are traveling on Interstate I-95 South, follow these directions:

- Take I-10 East in Metairie from Airport Road
- Follow I-10 East to Basin Street in New Orleans.
- Take Exit 235A from I-10 East
- Follow Basin Street to Canal Street
- The hotel will be 1 mile on Canal Street on your right

The hotel offers valet parking only at a rate of \$35.00 per day.
