

Functions of the Midwest Care Alliance (MCA) Board of Directors

The Board of Directors (BOD) has ultimate fiduciary authority to manage the business of the state organization, although it may delegate responsibilities to a President/CEO, agents or Board Committees. Whenever the Board delegates such responsibility, it will define the extent and limits of that authority.

The President/CEO of Midwest Care Alliance shall have full and entire charge of the day-to-day operations and business affairs of the organization.

Oversight, planning and advocacy activities of the BOD are accomplished, for example, through the following committees:
