Go to **My NCDA on the purple toolbar**, far right side and log in, and then click on "Online Journal" in the right hand column to access the archive.

Once you are logged in, create an e-mail alert to make sure you are notified when each new issue is published by selecting "Get New Content Alerts" from Journal Tools on the top of the left-hand side menu.
