This 8-hour, practice enhancing course is designed to teach participants how to perform a podiatric radiology examination. 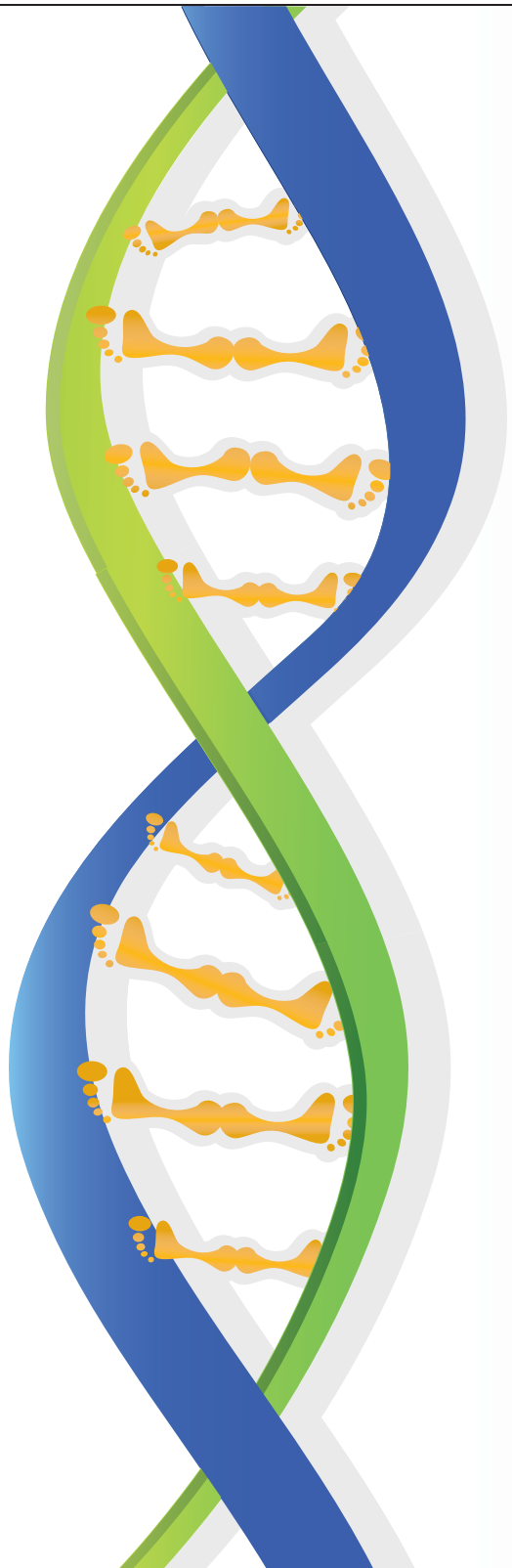
