Overview

The Leadership Development Academy provides an orientation for emergency medicine's future leaders and creates a pathway for physician leadership at the local, state, and national levels of organized emergency medicine. At Ohio ACEP, we believe that leadership is not about a job title. It's not an endowment of authority. **Leadership is an attitude, backed by a set of behaviors.** Anyone can be a leader.

Program Goals

- 1. Develop leaders in emergency medicine
- 2. Provide advocacy training to promote emergency medicine
- 3. Prepare program graduates for leadership positions
- 4. Encourage relationship-building, networking, and mentorship

Guidelines for Participation

- Nominee/Applicant must be a current member in good standing with Ohio ACEP and be board-certified or board-eligible in EM
- Nominee/Applicant must have a minimum of two years membership in ACEP or EMRA
- Attendance is required at all the sessions listed in the schedule plus additional conference calls as needed
- Cost for participation will be shared by Ohio ACEP and the physician

Participant Selection / Applications Due Feb 15

- The Leadership Development Committee will review and select participants based on completed nomination forms postmarked by February 15, 2017
- Selected participants will be notified immediately following the decision
- Nominees who are not selected for the 2017-2018 class may be re-nominated the following year

Cost Sharing

The participant is responsible for lodging, meals, and travel to/from all sessions listed in the program, including the ACEP Leadership & Advocacy Conference in Washington, DC, for the ACEP Leadership and Advocacy Conference and ACEP Council and events in Columbus, Ohio.

Ohio ACEP is responsible for all conference registration fees, speakers and program materials, leadership development tools and networking events.

Ohio ACEP will also be responsible for the May 2 and August 9 overnight accommodations and the Leadership Challenge® Program tuition.
