

Overview

The Leadership Development Academy provides an orientation and training for emergency medicine future leaders, a solid background in organized medicine and a pathway for physician leadership within the state chapter, national College, or local arena of emergency medicine.

Program Goals

- 1. Assist individuals to become leaders in emergency medicine by creating a personal leadership vision
- 2. Provide orientation and advocacy training to promote emergency medicine locally and nationally
- 3. Promote program graduates into leadership positions
- 4. Encourage relationship building

Guidelines for Participation

- Nominee/Applicant must be a current member in good standing of Ohio ACEP and board certified or board eligible in emergency medicine
- Nominee/Applicant must have a minimum of two years membership in ACEP or EMRA
- Attendance is required at **all the sessions listed** in the schedule plus additional conference calls as needed
- Cost for participation will be shared by Ohio ACEP and the physician

Participant Selection

- The Membership and Leadership Development Committee will review and select participants based on completed nomination forms postmarked by February 8, 2012
- Selected participants will be notified immediately following the decision
- Nominees who are not selected for the 2012 class may be re-nominated the following year

Cost Sharing

The participant is responsible for lodging, meals, and travel to/from all sessions listed in the program outline, including Washington, DC, for ACEP Leadership and Advocacy; Denver, Colorado for ACEP Council, and Columbus, Ohio.

Ohio ACEP is responsible for all conference registration fees; speakers and program materials; leadership development tools; and social and networking events.

Ohio ACEP will also be responsible for the two-day leadership challenge program, accommodations, tuition and on-site meals.
