New York Yankees hitting Coach Kevin Long and the Ohio State Baseball Coaching Staff are teaming up to offer their annual Coaches Clinic at The Ohio State University. The clinic will be a three hour symposium from 6 pm until 9 pm at The Huntington Club at Ohio Stadium located on the Ohio State campus. The Clinic is open to youth, club and high school coaches. Food will

be served during the Coaches Social. Yankees Hitting Coach Kevin Long and Ohio different players swing, and have a Q & A.

KEVIN LONG NEW YORK YANKEES

Kevin Long returned for his seventh season as the Yankees hitting coach in 2013. The Yankees have led the Majors in runs scored in three of his six years with the

club. The Yankees led all of Major League Baseball in Home Runs in each of the last two seasons (222 HR in 2011; 245 HR in 2012). In 2012, the Yankees led the league in Slugging Percentage (.453) and On-base Plus Slugging (.790) while finishing 2nd in runs scored (804) and On Base Percentage (.337).

Greg Beals is entering his 4th year at the helm of the Buckeye baseball program. In Beals first 3 years, the Buckeyes have cumulated a 93-76 record and made an appearance in the Big Ten Tournament in all 3 seasons. Under Beals direction, five players have been drafted in the annual Major League Baseball draft and six players, who played under Beals at Ohio State, are currently in Major League organizations. Before coming to Ohio State, Beals spent 8 years as the head baseball coach at Ball State University. Beals led the Cardinals to a 243-202 record in his time at Ball State University. Beals led division titles and also leading the Cardinals to a NCAA regional in 2006. In his 8 seasons at Ball State, 21 of Beals' players were selected in the Major League Baseball Draft.

ENROLLMENT

The fee for this clinic is \$60. If you are registering as part of a group of 4 or more coaches from your team, the registration fee is \$35 per coach. To receive the group discount, all registrations must be submitted together, along with payment, by mail. The camp is open to any and all youth, club and high school coaches, ages 18 and older. High school students are NOT permitted to attend this clinic. Full payment is required at the time of registration. You may register online by visiting OhioStateBuckeyes.com/camps. A 2.5% processing fee will be added to all online registrations. If registering by mail, please make your check payable to The Ohio State University.

MEALS & HOUSING

The Coaches Clinic is a day camp only and no overnight accommodations will be provided. Participants are responsible for providing their own overnight accommodations if needed. Hotel information can be provided upon request.

CONFIRMATION

Upon processing of each registration, a confirmation notice will be sent by email. A packet of "Important Information for Registered participants" will be posted online at OhioStateBuckeyes.com/ camps at least 2 weeks prior to the start of each camp.

Please check your email regularly, as this is our primary method of communication with participants.

REFUNDS

A full refund, less a \$10 administrative fee will be issued for any cancellation received by at least 2 weeks prior to the start of the clinic. The administrative fee and the 2.5% online processing are not refundable for ANY reason.

Because we have to guarantee our number of participants in order to prepare for the clinic, any cancellation received less than 2 weeks prior to the start of the clinic will not be eligible for any refund except in the case of illness or mandatory school event, in which case supporting documentation from a doctor or school is required.

A camp fee may not be transferred to any other Ohio State sports camp. A camp fee may not be transferred to any other participant. All cancellation notices must be received by the deadline above and submitted by mail, email, or fax - no phone calls or voicemails. All supporting documentation required for a refund to be approved and processed must be submitted within 10 days after the conclusion of the camp session. Refund requests must be submitted on the Refund Request Form available at OhioStateBuckeyes.com/ camps.
