- Go approx. 2.2 miles; TURN RIGHT onto 3rd St. • Go approx. 0.5 miles; TURN RIGHT onto Pery St. • Go 1 Block; TURN RIGHT onto 4th St.
- Go approx. 300 feet; TURN RIGHT into Lot C underground parking garage

From Southbound I-75:

From Westbound SR-35:


