From Northbound I-75:

(NOTE: THE 1st & 3rd ST. RAMPS ARE CLOSED DUE TO CONSTRUCTION)
• Exit at Edwin C. Moses Blvd. (Exit 51) •TURN RIGHT onto Edwin C. Moses
• Go approx. 2.2 miles; TURN RIGHT onto 3rd St. • Go approx. 0.5 miles;
TURN RIGHT onto Perry St. • Go 1 Block; TURN RIGHT onto 4th St.
• Go approx. 300 feet; TURN RIGHT into Lot C underground parking garage

From Southbound I-75:


