 - Authors screened 4,000+ articles; ultimately ~2,000 met criteria for inclusion in this analysis
 - Included articles were coded by category: integumentary, neurological, musculoskeletal, education, research, policy, cardiopulmonary
 - Big Findings = Over the past 30 years, there has been an increase in systematic reviews, qualitative studies, prospective studies, and inclusion of symptomatic patients in PT research.
 - What does all of this mean? It represents the strong trend towards evidence based practice! In PT, we are truly practicing what we preach ⓒ
