Dear SCAA member,

The HRSA Rural and Community Access to Emergency Devices Program, which provides grants to states to deploy AEDs in rural areas, may not be funded in Fiscal Year 2012. President Obama has proposed to “zero out” funding for the program in his FY 2012 budget. And to make matters worse, HRSA just unveiled a plan that would significantly reduce its current spending to \$236,000! While Congress ultimately decides the fate for the coming year, it is critical that we garner as much support for the continuation of this program NOW.

Here's where we need your help:

Senators Conrad and Grassley are circulating a “sign-on” letter throughout the Senate Appropriations Subcommittee on Labor, HHS and Education, asking committee members for continued support of a number of rural health programs (including HRSA's Rural AED Program) in the Fiscal Year 2010 Appropriations Bill.
