Based on the 2010 parochial statistics and the formula of allocation, as defined in bylaw 12.41.11 of the Constitution, Bylaws, and Continuing Resolutions of the Evangelical Church in America, the number of voting members allocated to the Southern Ohio Synod has been reduced from 21 to 18. The 18 must consist of: 11 lay members and 7 clergy; 2 must be people of color or persons whose primary language is other than English, and 2 must be either youth or young adults under the age of 30 at the time of election. According to the constitution of the Southern Ohio Synod S9.01.02 the Bishop is an ex-officio member of the Churchwide Assembly, and is included in the number of voting members. At the November meeting of the Synod Council, the council voted to make the Vice-President, an ex-officio voting member of the Churchwide Assembly as well. The Synod Council has allocated the remaining voting members into the following categories.
