- **A Synod-wide worship team** will lead a special worship service on Friday, June 5th, beginning at 6 pm. The service will be held at Gloria Dei Worship Center, Trinity Lutheran Seminary.
- **Assembly plenary sessions, including elections, Bible study, and Assembly business** will be held in the Capital Center Arena. Meetings will begin promptly June 5th at 10 am and June 6th at 9 am. All are welcome to attend, voting and non-voting members!
- **This year childcare** will be available for young children whose parents are attending the Assembly. Childcare will be made available by members of Christ Lutheran Church, 2314 East Main Street, Bexley, OH 43209. Registration information available on request.
- **The Display and Vendor area** will be extensive and convenient to the Assembly food and beverage area in the Capital Center Field House. Directions to Campus

From the North or South:

Travel I-71 to the Broad Street exit. Turn east (driving away from downtown) onto Broad Street and drive 2.5 miles to Drexel Avenue in Bexley. Turn right onto Drexel Avenue and continue south until Drexel ends in front of the campus at Main Street. Turn left (east) onto Main Street. At the next light, Pleasant Ridge Avenue, turn right (south).

From the West

Travel east on I-70 to the Bexley/Main Street exit. Exit at Bexley/Main Street. The exit ramp automatically turns onto Alum Creek Drive, which will lead end at Main Street (in front of the Kroger store). Turn right (east) on Main Street. At the fourth traffic light, turn right (south) on Pleasant Ridge Avenue.

From the East

Travel west on I-70 to the Livingston Avenue exit. Turn left (west) on Livingston Avenue. Turn right (north) at the first traffic light onto Alum Creek Drive. When Alum Creek dead ends in front of the Kroger store, turn right (east) on Main Street. At the fourth traffic light, turn right (south) on Pleasant Ridge Avenue.

From the Northwest

Travel south on I-75 to Route 23. Follow Route 23 into Columbus and take I-270 east to I-71 South. Travel south on I-71 to the Broad Street exit. Turn east (driving away from downtown) onto Broad Street and drive 2.5 miles to Drexel Avenue in Bexley. Turn right onto Drexel Avenue and continue south until Drexel ends in front of the campus at Main Street. Turn left (east) onto Main Street. At the next light, Pleasant Ridge Avenue, turn right (south).
