### B. Background

- A summary of previous published research relating to the proposed research.
- A summary of previous research, writing, or practical experience by the applicant(s) and its relationship to the proposed study.

### C. Methods

- A detailed methodology including the number of subjects to be included, method of subject recruitment and selection, data to be collected, data analysis process, and plans for public presentation or publication of data. Include the roles of all personnel involved and plans for access to any special resources.
- Timeline of proposed project

## **Budget**

- Include a detailed list of expenses

## **Human Subject Approval**

Should your research project be accepted, you will be expected to receive approval by an Ethics Review Board or other such Human Research Review Committee (HRRC). These review boards are often an established part of an institution, college or university. There are also privately run HRRCs. These ethics review committees serve to ensure the safety, anonymity and right to full disclosure for subjects involved in original research. If using human subjects, please briefly describe how you plan to seek approval for the use of human subjects or if you will need assistance with this aspect of your project.

## **Principle Investigator Bios**
