With all that is going on in the world, Karl asked the most fundamental question:

Are we fundraising for our four recipients, or are we thinking the bigger picture...40 recipients and on!

Discussion on this question:

Fabio:

If we learn how to fundraise and we get the knack of it and we know the drill and we get really good at it, I say "Why not? Why not fundraise for 40 people?" We're new to fundraising land, there are techniques and strategies that go along with that, I've worked for STRAB who had a budget when I left of 2.5 million dollars...they are doing things all the time...a team of women worked day and night and a congressman would come visit and a fancy architect would come visit...it was her [???] mission to raise money.

We need to connect with the right people and knock at the right door.

BUT I also think our main goal right now is to make sure our four recipients are taken care of.

We would need grant writers in every state? Having every recipient from a different state is a challenge

Karl:

My desire is to focus as soon as possible to fund the four who are already training. We will get more creative as we do that, if AmSAT is going to survive and make it through the 21st-century, this is one of the essential part of making sure of that.

Rebecca:

I'm with Fabio. If we learn how to fundraise I would be interested in revisiting this next year to expand the number of recipients. If we can raise 10K or 15K this year, are we getting lucky or do we know what we are doing? How much is good will and how much is sustainable.

Karl:

We need to establish and expand a donor base. That is part of our learning process. We have a really great start at establishing donors.

Fabio:

Going back to my experience at STRAB, there was a woman who would just hang out with wealthy people and get them to write a check. Schmoozing. and Trust. When she left, they went with her.

(Other people were applying for grants, etc.)

Tagging along the diversity idea, STRAB had a school for kids of all colors, they were big on showing that, look at us, our school is open to everybody. This was very appealing to donors.

Karl:

There's a fact we have to come to terms with ...having worked with a Catholic university and Catholic donors, their philosophy of what to do about racial equality is to throw money at it. That is all they want, not to deal with anything else.

A young women from Jamaica would cry after the events to raise money about how the white Catholic guys were who were paying for medical training in Jamaica.

Jessica:

So many of our donors beyond our membership so believe in what we want to do, they are being very generous. We want to keep those people interested.

Fabio, Sandra, Rebecca: how to reach them?

- Send new website link
- Send news of what we've done
- We're back here again!
- We can't contain our selves!
- Advice from a realtor to Rebecca: Your job is to be in people's faces and let them tell you they've had enough.
- The people who have so far donated to us have a lot of goodwill for our initiative

Renee:

I think our AmSAT membership is getting older, or maybe the young people aren't joining, I would love to see that the more established teachers who can afford it can contribute now but can leave money to us.

There is also an emotional commitment to that.

Jessica:

I agree Renee that emotionally I'm not sure we can all stay with this for 3-5 years, but we can do this work for the people who come afterward.

Sandra:

Teach one lesson...Teachers who can contribute are

Renee: If you say it is for a friend, no. Otherwise 2.9% for business; 2.2% for fundraising/5013C.

Renee, Karl, Jessica:

We want our donors to have the experience of clicking on a donation button and entering the amount they want to donate and their cc or paypal info and be done with it.

ONLY HAVING TO WORRY ABOUT HOW MUCH THEY ARE GIVING

We can write in there that we need to be able to have our donors donate directly to authroize,net, OR our own dedicated donation spot on the AmSAT website, OR permission to use PayPal or Donorbox to gather donations expediently.

Taskforce: To change the donation link on the website so that we can continue our outreach.

TIMELINE for the WEBSITE
