

Estimated Population Change by State (2010-2020)






Ohio Population Change by County




State of Ohio Job Growth by County




State of Ohio Unemployment





State of Ohio GRP Growth

Total by County (2018-2022)











(August 2020- July 2023)







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

(August 2020- July 2023)








