Dr. Cory E. Cronin is an associate professor and chair in Ohio University's Department of Social and Public Health and the co-director of the Institute to Advance Population Health. He received his PhD in medical sociology from Case Western Reserve University, and he has also earned a Master of Health Services Administration from Xavier University. Dr. Cronin has expertise in health care delivery and health care policy, and his research largely focuses on using quantitative data and administrative records to explore population health issues. He has particular interest in how health care organizations, policy, and environment promote or detract from health and health care access, particularly in regard to vulnerable populations such as rural communities.
