



Home Screen – select “Apply for License”




Selection the type of license you are applying for. In this example we selected – Resident Licensing



Scroll down and select Colorado





Review Information to decide if you are applying as an "Individual" or "Business". Click on "APPLY HERE"

For Business License – select Search Type (most likely FEIN number) Click on “I accept the NIPR Use Agreement – NEXT




