HB 1 Tax System Rewrite (<u>Mathews, A.</u>) To modify the law regarding property taxation and income tax rates. <u>Text/Analysis</u> Committee Hearing in House <u>Ways & Means</u> (4/18/2023)

CTAO Position: Monitoring

HB 3 Affordable Housing (<u>Pavliga, G., McNally, L.</u>) To formally state the General Assembly's intention to authorize an affordable housing tax credit. <u>Text/Analysis</u> Committee Hearing in House <u>Economic & Workforce Development</u> (3/28/2023; CONTINUED (No testimony))

HB 4 Economic Boycotts (Young, T., King, A.)

To declare the General Assembly's intention to enact legislation regarding financial institutions and other businesses that conduct economic boycotts or discriminate against certain companies or customers based on certain factors.

HB 33 Operating Budget (Edwards, J.)

To make operating appropriations for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, and ending June 30, 2025, to levy taxes, and to provide authorization and conditions for the operation of state programs.

HB 57 Homestead Exemption (Hall, T., Demetriou, S.) To index the homestead exemption amounts to inflation. <u>Text/Analysis</u> Committee Hearing in House Ways & Means (4/18/2023)

HB 60 Homestead Exemptions (<u>Troy, D.</u>) To increase the amount of and expand the income qualifications for the homestead exemption. <u>Text/Analysis</u> Committee Hearing in House <u>Ways & Means</u> (4/18/2023)

HB 64 Eminent Domain (<u>Kick, D., Creech, R.</u>) To modify the law regarding eminent domain. <u>Text/Analysis</u> Committee Hearing in House <u>Civil Justice</u> (3/21/2023)

HB 85 Land Banks (<u>Patton, T.</u>) To expand the methods by which land banks can acquire delinquent property. <u>Text/Analysis</u> Referred in House (3/14/2023; <u>State & Local Government</u>)

HB 90 Disabled Veterans (<u>Patton, T.</u>) To authorize a total property tax exemption for the homesteads of totally disabled veterans and their surviving spouses. <u>Text/Analysis</u> Referred in House (3/14/2023; <u>Ways & Means</u>)

HB 93 Utilities (Johnson, M., McClain, R.)

Regards limitations on recovery and lien imposition by municipalities against property owners of non-owner-occupied properties for unpaid water, sewer, and disposal services rates and charges. <u>Text/Analysis</u>

Referred in House (3/14/2023; State & Local Government)

CTAO Position: Monitoring – CTAO Opposed this bill last General Assembly

HB 134 Tax Certificate Sales (<u>Dell'Aquila, R., Galonski, T.</u>) To require notice to lienholders in tax certificate sales. <u>Text/Analysis</u> Committee Hearing in House Ways & Means (4/18/2023)

CTAO Position: Monitoring – CTAO has met with the sponsor and been in discussions with Ohio Bankers League & Ohio Community Bankers Assn, proponents of the bill

<u>SB 2</u> Property Tax (<u>Schuring, K.</u>)
To authorize certain subdivisions to designate areas within which certain residential property is wholly or partially exempted from property taxation.

Referred in Senate (1/17/2023; <u>Finance</u>)

<u>SB 3</u> Community Revitalization (<u>Schuring, K.</u>) To create the Ohio Community Revitalization Program, authorizing nonrefundable income tax credits for undertaking community projects. <u>Text/Analysis</u> Referred in Senate (1/17/2023; <u>Ways & Means</u>)

CTAO Position: Monitoring

<u>SB 25</u> Foreclosures (<u>Hackett, B.</u>) Relates to real property foreclosures. <u>Text/Analysis</u> Committee Hearing in Senate <u>Judiciary</u> (3/29/2023; CONTINUED (See separate story))

CTAO Position: Opponent. Letter of Opposition drafted and shared with bill's sponsor, Sherriff's, Auditor's, Prosecutor's, and Judicial Conference.



<u>SB 36</u> Foreclosures (<u>Blessing, L.</u>)

To grant tenants and certain other eligible bidders rights relating to the purchase of residential property sold at foreclosure. <u>Text/Analysis</u> Committee Hearing in Senate Community Revitalization (3/22/2023; CONTINUED)

<u>SB 43</u> Veteran Homestead Exemption (<u>Brenner, A.</u>) To modify the homestead exemption for the surviving spouse of a disabled veteran. <u>Text/Analysis</u> Passed in Senate (3/29/2023; 31-0)

<u>SB 74</u> Treasurer Of State (<u>Gavarone, T.</u>) Regards the Treasurer of State and the electronic payment of taxes. <u>Text/Analysis</u> Committee Hearing in Senate <u>Ways & Means</u> (3/29/2023; CONTINUED)

<u>SB 76</u> Landlords (<u>Blessing, L., Antonio, N.</u>)
To levy a tax on certain high-volume landlords.
