## CORNELIUS GREEN

Cornelius Green is in a small fraternity of football players who played in four Rose Bowl Games. Green made history as the first African American to start as guarterback for the Buckeyes. Green played for Ohio State in the 1973 Rose Bowl Game, then started in the 1974, 1975 and 1976 games. In the 1974 game, Green was named MVP in a 42-21 victory over USC. Legendary head coach Woody Hayes described the 1974 Rose Bowl Game as "the best game we've ever. EVER played." Green's third quarter touchdown run broke a 21-21 tie and gave the Buckeyes a lead they would not relinquish. Green accumulated 454 yards of offense and scored two touchdowns in the 1975 and 1976 games. The 1975 Chicago Tribune Silver Football award winner as the Big Ten's best player, Green was 31-3-1 as a starter.
