Proper Care of Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

Maintaining PPE properly is essential to ensure its effectiveness and extend its lifespan. Follow these best practices:

Cleaning Procedures

Reusable PPE: Clean according to the manufacturer's instructions using approved detergents and disinfectants.

Single-Use PPE: Dispose of after each use. Do not attempt to clean or reuse.

Inspection

Before Each Use:

Inspect PPE for signs of damage, wear, or contamination.

Immediate Replacement: Replace any compromised PPE immediately to ensure safety.

Storage

Keep it Dry: Store PPE in a cool, dry location away from direct sunlight and moisture.

Stay Organized: Use designated storage areas to avoid cross-contamination and ensure accessibility.

Ensure all personnel are properly trained in:

Care and maintenance procedures

Recognizing PPE limitations
