Lineman Apprentice Progression Program (LAPP)

Purpose

The Indiana Municipal Electric Association (IMEA) developed the Lineman Apprentice Progression Program (LAPP) to deliver the education, hands-on training, and structured administration required to meet U.S. Department of Labor (DOL) apprenticeship standards. This multi-year program is designed to guide apprentices through a structured path of progressive learning—both in the classroom and in the field—culminating in full journeyman qualification.

Program Structure

The LAPP is a four-year program consisting of workshops, guided study, and practical skills development. Each year builds on the last, ensuring apprentices gain both the theoretical knowledge and practical skills needed to succeed in the electric utility industry.
