THE SOLUTION

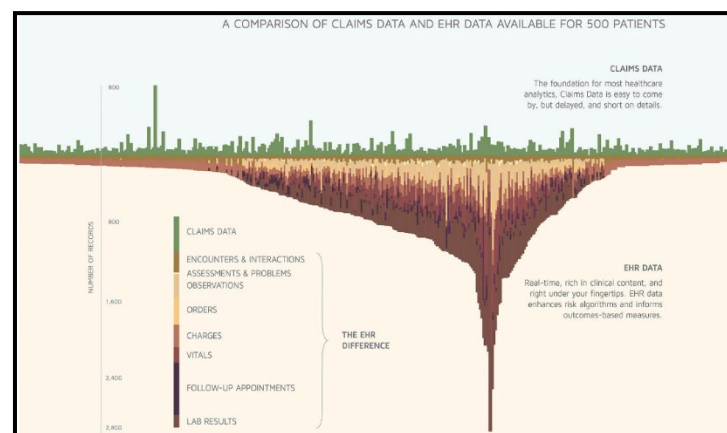
The Kentucky Health Information Exchange (KHIE) facilitates clinical data exchange across the Commonwealth of Kentucky, neighboring states, and connected exchanges.

KHIE is an industry leader as KHIE supports various protocols and standards through the implementation of **enhanced services to empower healthcare providers** to improve the quality, safety, and efficiency of care. KHIE has the ability to **influence the way healthcare is planned, coordinated, and delivered**.

KHIE is a tool that supports clinical care coordination to **improve health outcomes** and **reduce healthcare costs** in Kentucky.

NETWORK

Since being founded in 2010, KHIE has grown to become one of the largest state-wide HIEs in the nation!



GROW

Since 2017, KHIE has seen remarkable growth:

- 135% increase in live data feeds
- 63% increase in participating organizations connected to KHIE
- 155% increase in healthcare locations sending patient health data
- 100% increase in individuals available in the Master Patient Index (MPI)



LEAD

KHIE is a national HIE leader, ranking among statewide HIEs:

- 1st in number of overall connections (e.g., labs, hospitals, etc.)
- 1st in unique patients searchable in the MPI
- 2nd in number of participating organizations connected to KHIE

Expansive Data

KHIE is a secure network that meets national standards to ensure interoperability. KHIE receives data from **8,000+ individual feeds** while 98% of Kentucky hospitals contribute data to KHIE.

Clinical Documentation

KHIE's robust data storage enhances provider access to real-time patient information. Over **293 million clinical documents** are stored in KHIE. In June 2021 alone, over 893,000 Event Notifications were sent through KHIE.

KHIE continues to improve user capabilities through new services and enhancements offered to our Participants. Currently, more than **3,300 Healthcare Professionals** are connected to the KHIE ePartnerViewer.

COVID-19 Response

KHIE collaborates with other state entities, including KDPH, for the collective COVID-19 response. More than **4.5 million COVID-19 tests** were routed through KHIE to NEDSS since the start of the pandemic, in addition to 1 million immunizations sent to KYIR.

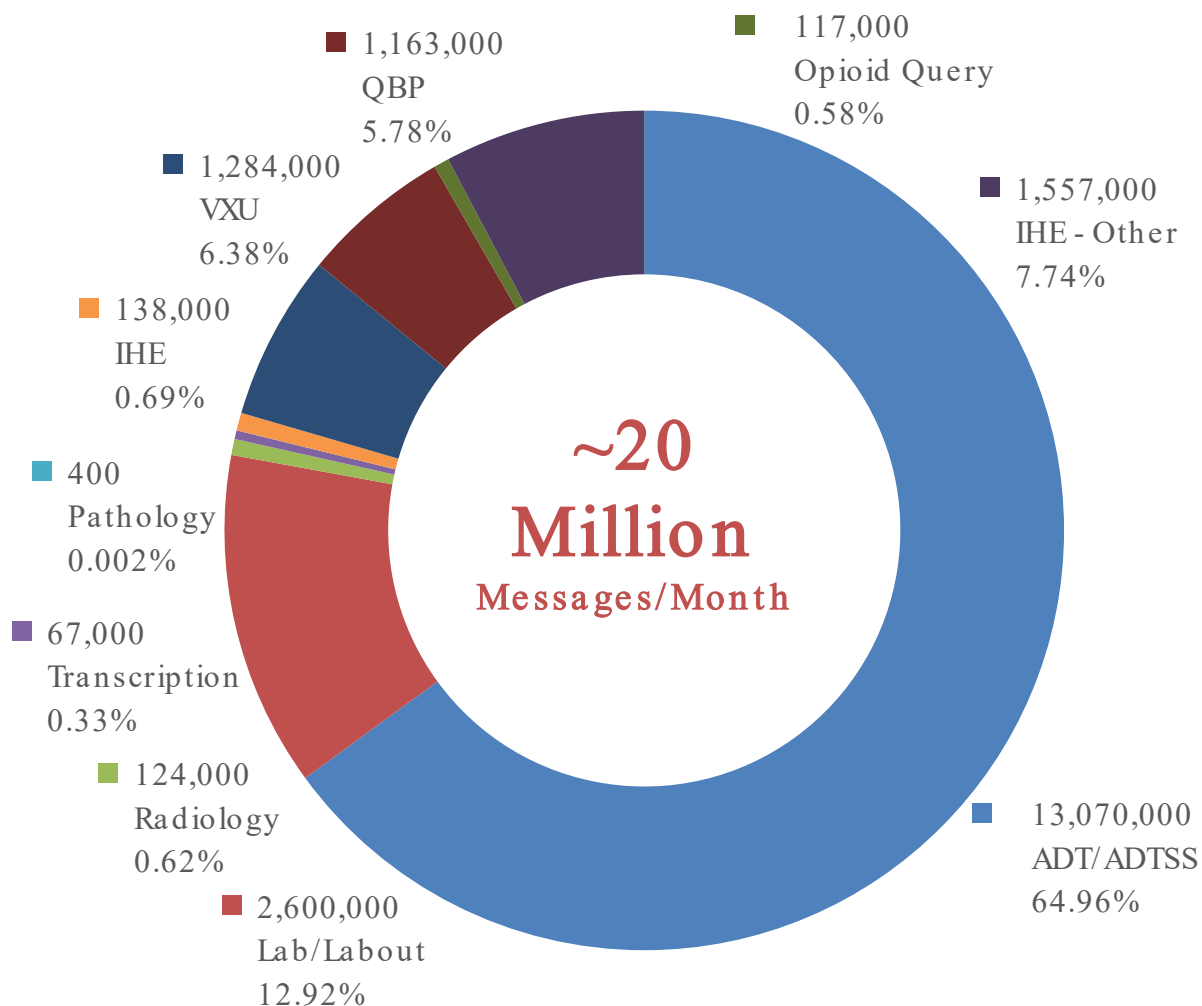
MESSAGES PER MONTH

KHIE currently **processes ~20 million messages per month.**

- From Jan 21' to Mar 21', KHIE observed a 25% increase in messages processed per month on average versus the same monthly average in 2020.
- Assuming current volumes observed from January to March hold steady, KHIE is projected to receive ~240 million messages by the end of this year.

ADTs account for the **largest portion** of the data that **KHIE receives.**

The **amount of data** KHIE receives is increasing dramatically **due to a rapid expansion in Participant Onboarding.**

KHIE Services

Medicaid Continuity of Care

Electronically generate patient-specific clinical summary documents that include appropriate Medicaid IDs with Medicaid Claims Data

Direct Secure Messaging

Securely enables patient health information directly to another known and trusted recipient

Summary Continuity of Care

Electronically generate patient-specific clinical summary documents to enhance communications during transitions of care

Image Exchange

Providers may view, share, and export clinical images to local Picture Archiving and Communication Systems (PACS)

Patient Alert Query

Retrieves the latest information about a patient and flags specific high impact conditions

Social Determinants of Health (SDoH)

Access recent social determinants of health data through a collaboration with kynect resources

Event Notifications

Inform healthcare providers when a patient is admitted to, transferred, or discharged from various settings

Electronic Case Reporting

Report infectious diseases to the Department for Public Health through the connection with the Association of Public Health Laboratories (APHL) Informatics Messaging Service (AIMS)

Platinum Connection

Support Cross-Enterprise Document Sharing (XDS.b) and Cross-Community Access (XCA) IHE framework standards to push/pull data between KHIE and the Participant's EMR/EHR

Direct Data Entry

Manually enter data, which is instantly stored in the HIE

ePartnerViewer

Access real-time historical and clinical data through a customizable health portal

Public Health Registries and Reporting

Electronically submit data and reports as KHIE is connected to state and national registries, including KYIR and NEDSS



ePartnerViewer

PROVIDING ACTIONABLE DATA

The ePartnerViewer, Kentucky's Provider ePortal, is a **customizable health record portal** that offers users a view of real-time and historical clinical data from more than 6500 healthcare facilities.

KHIE's Patient Alert Queries help providers **stay informed about high visibility conditions**. The Patient Alert Queries service **retrieves the latest information** about a patient when they are searched in the ePartnerViewer or an organization's EMR/EHR system and **flags specific high impact conditions**.

CareAlign PORTAL

CareAlign is a web portal for users who do not have an EHR, or one without direct capabilities, to send direct secure messages.

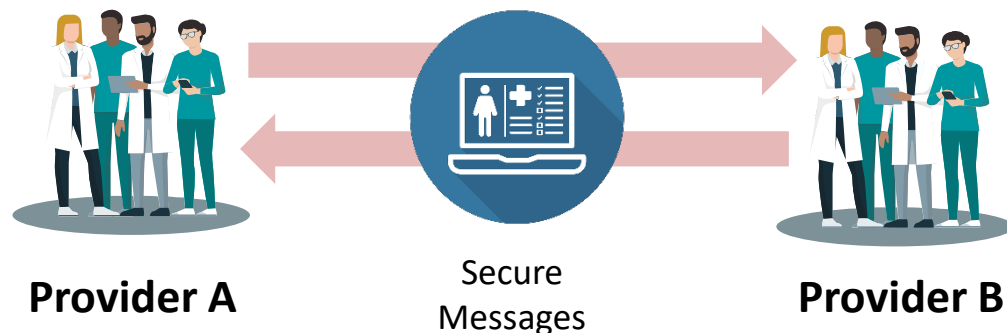

The direct secure messaging services allows for simple, secure, stable, and standards-based way for users to send messages directly to recipient's EHR.

Image Exchange



A Diagnostic Image Enablement Solution

Facilitates clinical collaboration by breaking down departmental and organizational silos, enabling providers the ability to access and/or exchange medical images across connected organizations.



Integrating with the ePartnerViewer

Streamlines access to clinical images by allowing users, such as radiology administrative staff, to open the ePartnerViewer, search a patient, and preview radiology studies for that patient from other hospitals and providers.



Interoperability Capabilities

Provides the ability to exchange imaging data with other imaging systems, depending on connection capabilities, which will reduce the need for new radiology studies, disparate documents, and CD drive management.



Image Exchange

WITH IMAGE INABLEMENT

Systems with Image Enablement have a more holistic understanding of their patient imaging data while reducing duplicative imaging tests.



Minimize technology barriers, increase access to clinical images and eliminate need of CDs



Lower healthcare costs by reducing the amount of duplicate procedure



Improve patient satisfaction and **avoid re-exposure to radiation**



Improve speed of care continuum through securely exchanging imaging data with other organizations

WITHOUT IMAGE INABLEMENT

Systems without Image Enablement may lead to incomplete and inaccurate patient imaging data while having a higher cost associated with imaging.



Increase materials and labor costs for burning imaging discs average \$25 each



Increase risk of HIPAA violations by sharing images with contracted entities without additional security measures



Create **expensive re-work and increased administrative burden** resulting in higher costs for hospital and patients



Increase time to treat the patient due to repeat imaging procedures



Social Determinants of Health

KHIE is collaborating with Kentucky's Resource Engine, kynect resources, to **create standardized, actionable Social Determinant of Health (SDoH) data** to improve holistic care coordination by linking residents to Community Partners and engaged healthcare organizations.

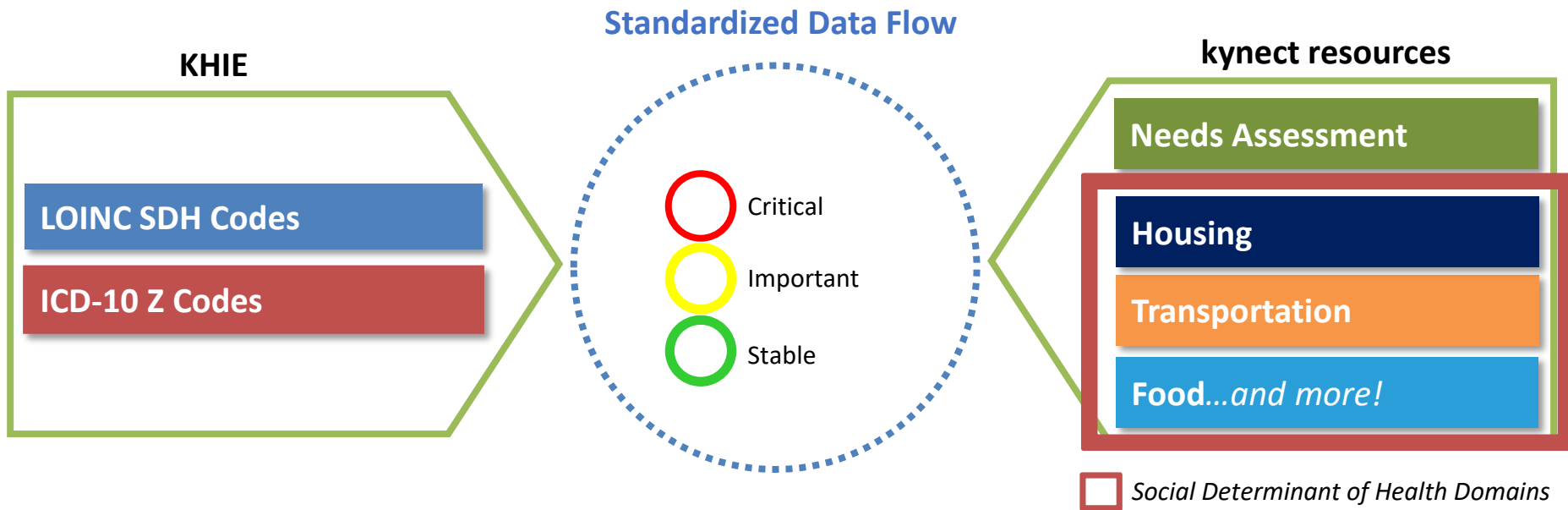


Per County Health Rankings

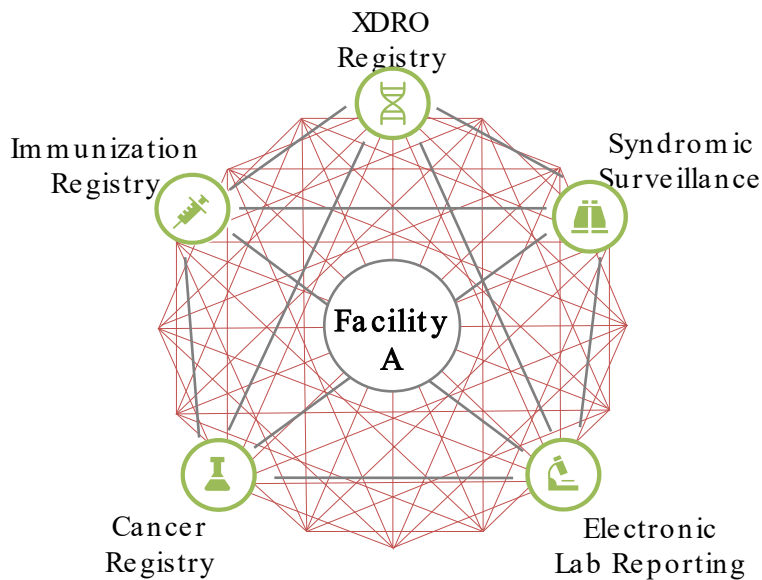
KHIE developed and now utilizes an **in-house tool** that **aligns SDoH data** found in **ICD-10 Z** and **LOINC SDH codes** to the **kynect resources Needs Assessment**.

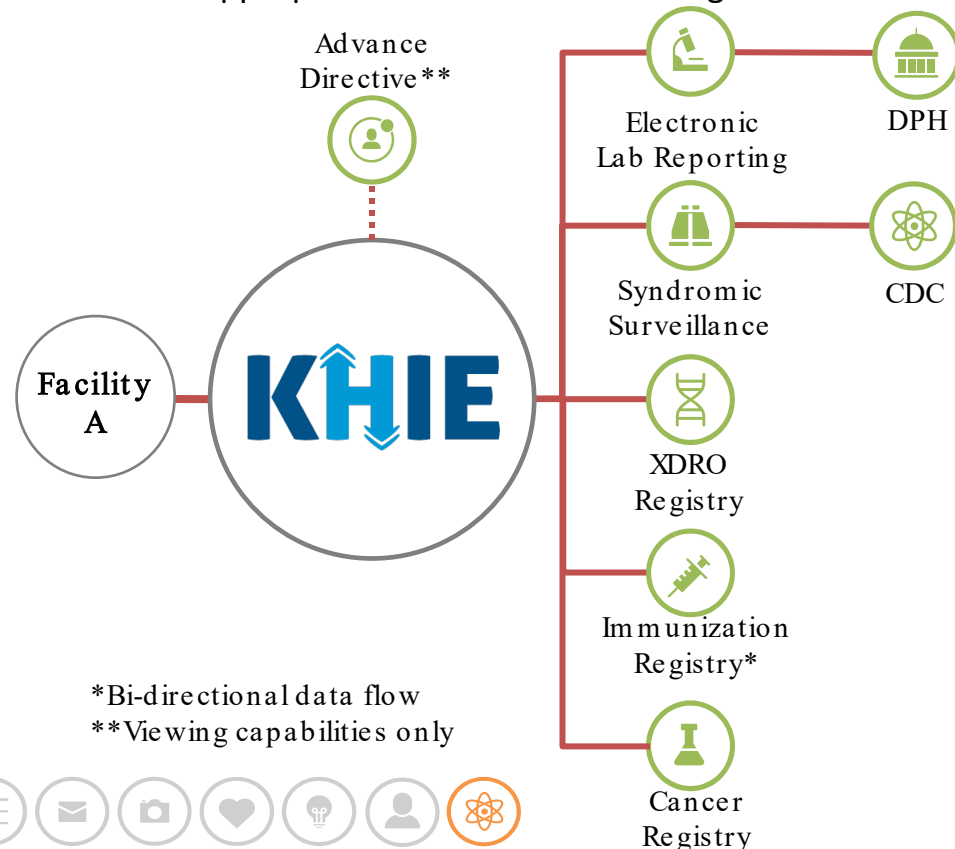
TRADITIONAL CONNECTIONS

Historically, facilities would have to build connection points to individual registries.



KHIE CONNECTION

Now, KHIE automatically directs the facility's data to the appropriate location with one single connection.



COVID-19 Reporting



Lab Results

- Logs the test and test results
- Used for positivity rating
- Positive and negative results must be submitted to DPH or LHD
 - Positive within 24 hours
 - Negative within 7 days



Case Reports

- Provides details of the case and individual
- Only required for positive results
- One form submitted to LHD

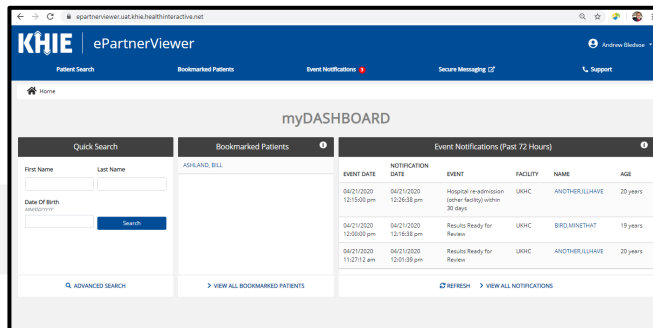

GATHERING REAL-TIME DATA

Direct Data Entry (DDE) creates a workflow in the ePartnerViewer that allows end-users to submit laboratory record information directly into KHIE. The DDE workflow **contains validations to ensure data quality**.
