After line 111186, insert:

"Sec. 5162.67. (A) Not later than December 31, 2025, the
medicaid director shall convene a civil money penalty
reinvestment program advisory committee consisting of not more
than two representatives from each of the following entities or
groups:

(1) The department of medicaid;

(2) The academy of senior health sciences;

(3) Leadingage Ohio;

(4) The Ohio health care association;

(5) Nursing home operators;

(6) Academic or research institutions.

(B) Beginning January 1, 2026, the advisory group shall
meet twice annually to review the following data to be provided
by the department of medicaid about the civil money penalty
program:

(1) Program fund balances;

<u>(2) Utilization of funds granted through the program;</u>	18
<u>(3) Any grants that have been awarded and funding that has</u>	19
<u>been denied through the program;</u>	20
<u>(4) Key findings from grant-funded projects and programs;</u>	21
<u>(5) Any other related information that the committee deems</u>	22
<u>necessary.</u>	23
<u>(C) Not later than December 31, 2026, and annually</u>	24
<u>thereafter, the advisory committee shall issue a report that</u>	25
<u>includes the data that the committee has collected and reviewed</u>	26
<u>and recommendations regarding the operation and utilization of</u>	27
<u>the civil money penalty reinvestment program. The report shall</u>	28
<u>be submitted to the speaker of the house of representatives and</u>	29
<u>the president of the senate."</u>	30
