KNOW THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN A HURRICANE "WATCH" AND "WARNING"

Listen for National Weather Service alerts on TV or radio or check for them online.



A **HURRICANE WATCH** means hurricane conditions (sustained winds of 74 miles per hour [mph] or higher) are possible in a stated area.



A HURRICANE WARNING is more serious. It means hurricane-force winds are expected in a stated area.
