SUMMARY: In 2004, the Athol Board of Health enacted a health regulation that banned smoking in "membership associations" (private clubs). A group of local private clubs sued the town. In 2006, the Massachusetts Supreme Judicial Court found that the town was within their authority to impose the smoking ban on private clubs (<u>American Lithuanian Naturalization Club, Athol, Mass., Inc., & others vs. Board of Health of Athol & another, 446 Mass. 310).</u>
