In all above instances, the smoking bar exemption found in the state law has been removed, banning smoking in “smoking bars. * = language bans smoking bars. + = grandfathered one

Ban on “smoking” in smoking bars: 128 (33 cities in bold) – 48.8% of state’s population (3,407,201) lives in listed municipalities.

Ban on smoking bars: 31 (4 cities in bold) – 9.64% of state’s population (673,163) lives in listed municipalities.
