Breakdown of Funding



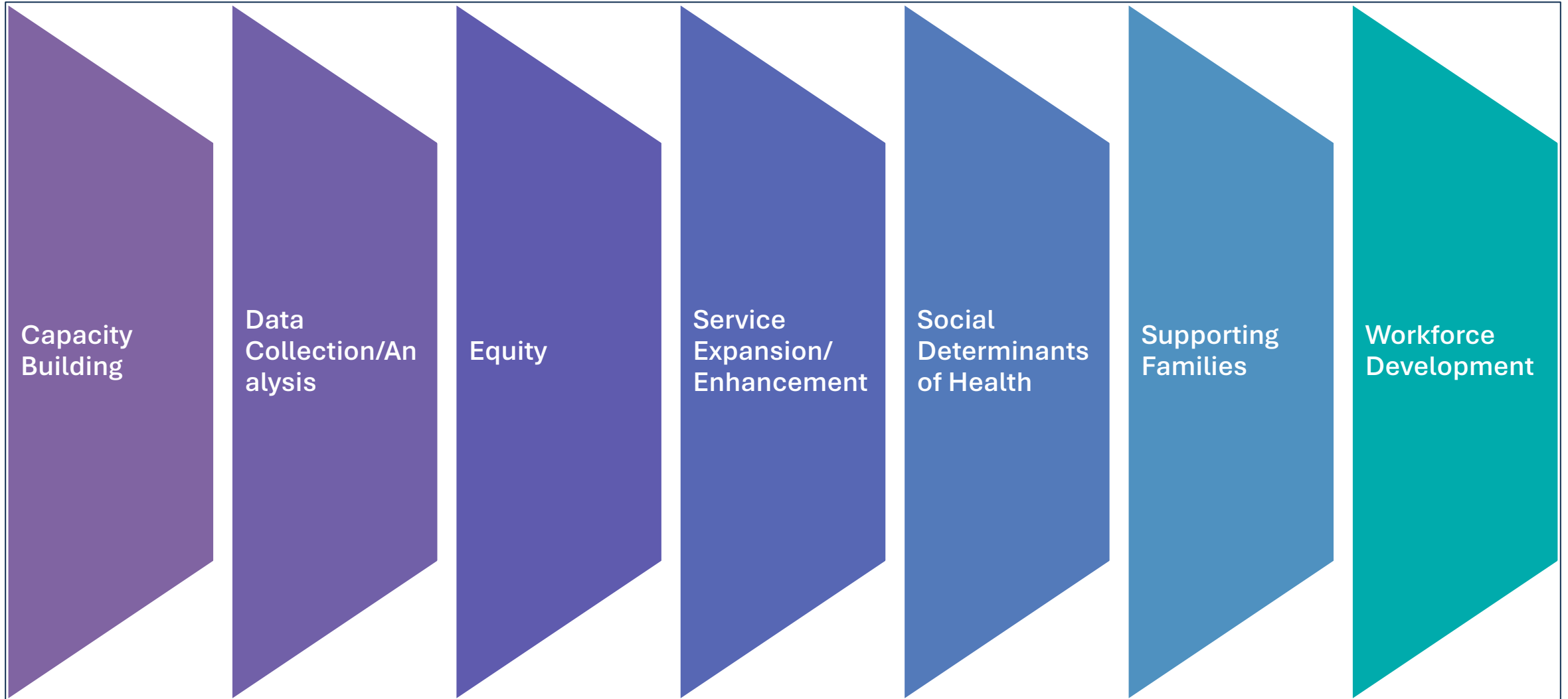
State Subdivision Agreement

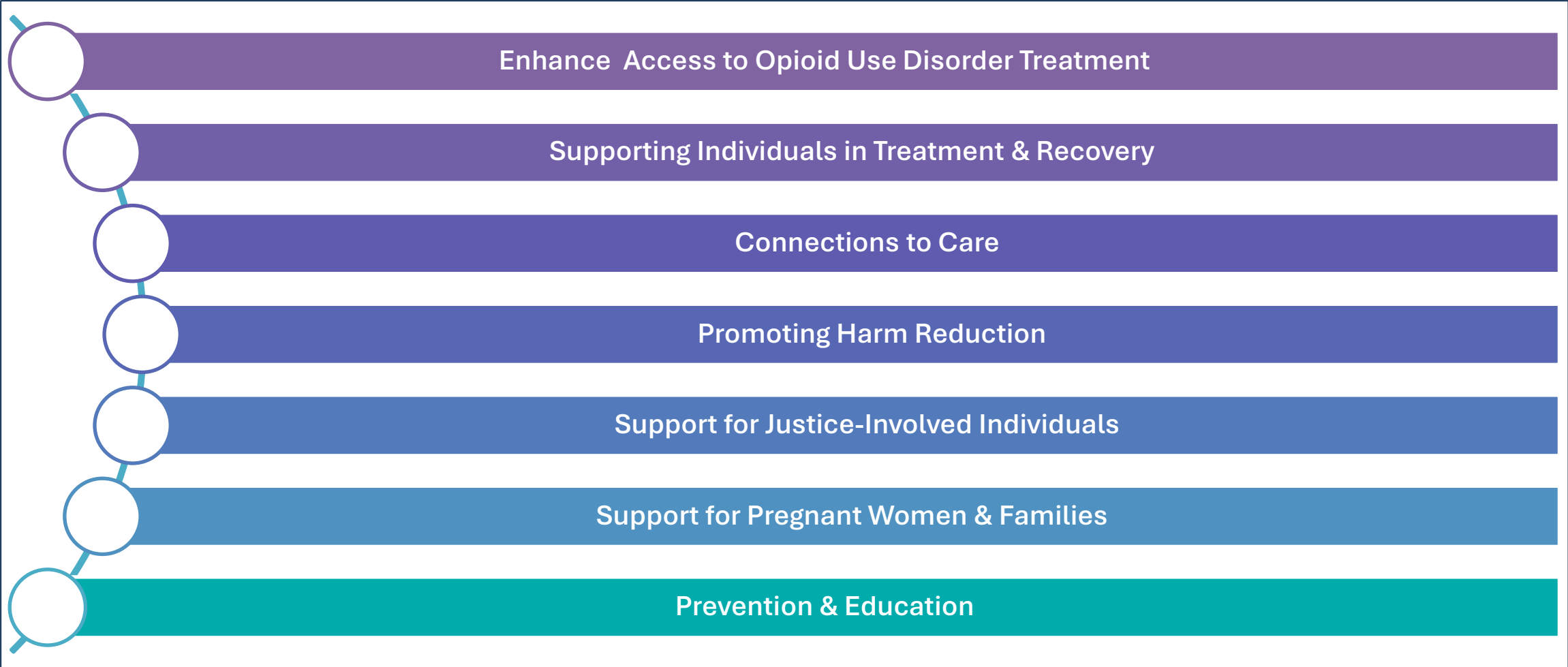

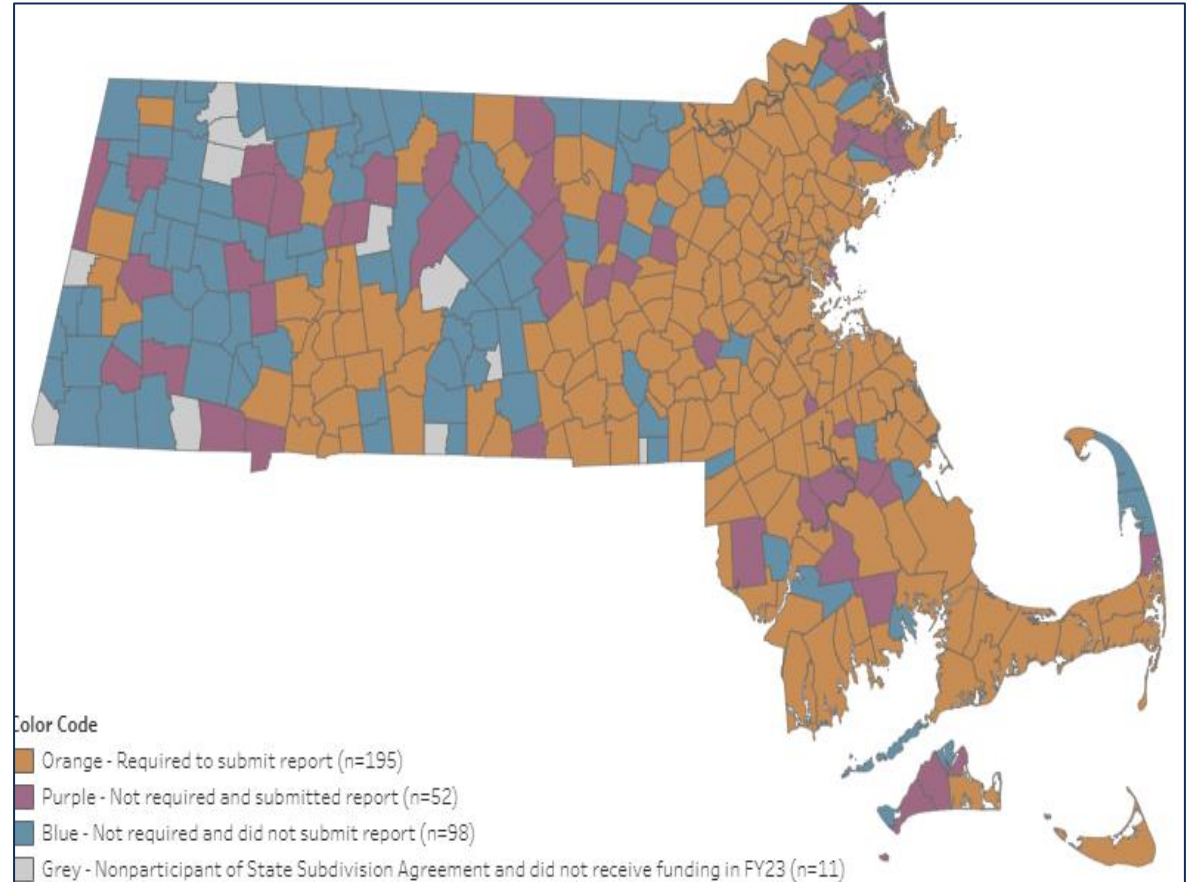


Municipal Opioid Abatement Funds Cont.

 - Strategies & Stage of Implementation
 - Expenditures
- Annual Payment \$35,000 +
- FY23 & FY24

Municipal Expenditure Dashboard

Municipal Training & Technical Assistance

- Responding to informational requests about statewide settlement fund
- Facilitating meaningful engagement with people who use drugs and those with lived and living experience
- Speaking engagements at community meetings and events
- Supporting the development of Opioid Abatement Collaboratives (OAC)
- Sharing research and literature on evidence-informed interventions
- Developing tools and materials that support strategic planning and implementation
- Providing guidance and insight on appropriate uses of funds
