**Summary:** Requires license to sell nicotine or tobacco products at retail.

### **SB 463 Criminal Penalties (Singh)**

**Summary:** Sunsets criminal penalties and civil sanctions for minors that purchase, possess, or use tobacco products, vapor products, or alternative nicotine products.

### **SB 464 Tobacco/Nicotine Licenses (Bellino)**
