

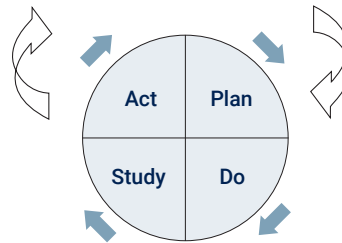

ASCO'S Quality Training Program brings cancer care teams together to select, design, and implement a quality improvement project at their practices. Examples of projects[†] can include:

- Oral Chemotherapy
- Care Coordination
- Patient Safety
- Documentation Improvement
- Process Improvement
- Patient Access
- Patient Education
- ER Visit Reduction

The 6-month program includes five days of in-person learning across three sessions, as well as hands-on learning at the participants' practices. Sessions include seminars, case examples, and small group exercises. Teams must:

- Have an active member of ASCO in their practice (member may also be a fellow in training).
- Assemble a core team of 2–5 participants.
- Ensure that the core team members attend the three in-person meetings.

What is QTP?

QTP is a six-month course designed to help your practice improve the quality of cancer care delivery. The course elevates medical and non-medical staff members of the care team into higher-functioning quality improvement teams, identifies practice-specific areas for development, and gives you the tools and strategies necessary to make change.
