

Mr. Mark Lundine is the Economic Development Administrator for the City of Columbus. He leads the City's economic development division which is responsible for assisting businesses create jobs and invest in real estate throughout the City of Columbus. The Division is focused on business expansion and attraction, public infrastructure investments to spur the growth of employment centers and small business investments. The Division has partnered with businesses to grow Columbus economy through job creation commitments of over 70,000 new and retained jobs and \$7.4 billion in private sector investments over the last 10 years. Mr. Lundine helped to grow the City's P3 (public private partnership) program. It is an innovative approach to infrastructure development that creates an efficient, reliable system for executing complex projects involving public and private development partners. He has also helped lead the implementation of the City's Small Business Agenda providing critical small business services, financing and loans to thousands of small businesses across the City. Finally, Mr. Lundine helped establish a regional C-PACE (Property Assessed Clean Energy) program that has led to more 50 projects and \$200 million in energy improvement upgrades throughout the Columbus region over the last 5 years.
