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Activities to Date

- June 2019 issue submitted to production November 14, 2018.
- September 2019 issue submitted February 11, 2019.
- December 2019 issue submitted May 10, 2019.
- March 2020 issue submitted August 16, 2019.
- Responded to numerous inquiries about CDQ policy, NCDA resources, manuscripts, publication guidelines, journal ratings, etc.
- 19 editorial members approved for re-appointment.
- 8 individuals approved for new editorial board appointment.
- 7 editorial board members ended service after 3 two-year terms:

- Journal statistics for the prior 12-month period:
 - 135 manuscripts received; 67 manuscripts rejected without review (inappropriate); accept ratio = 23.8%
 - average time to assign reviewer = 1.8 days; average reviewer turnaround time = 27.2 days
 - average time from submission to first decision = 16.6 days; average time from submission to final decision = 25.9 days
- Impact Factor = .93 (2-year), 1.6 (5-year).
- Full text downloads via Wiley Online Library increased by 10%, from 37,960 in 2016 to 41,580 in 2017.
- CDQ ranks 46 of 82 applied psychology journals worldwide (from most current data, 2017)
- Presented program on publishing at 2019 NCDA annual meeting
