SCHOLARSHIP

The **NFBA Foundation** offers \$2,000 scholarships to students who are NFBA member company employees or who are family members of NFBA member company employees. Applicants must be enrolled in a college, university, technical institute, or trade school, or planning to enroll in such an institution this year.

Applications and required supporting materials must be returned to the **NFBA Foundation** Office by May 1st.

Each scholarship shall be a one-time payment of \$2,000 that will be paid directly to the educational institution on behalf of the recipient. Student ID number and remittance information for your school will be requested when winning recipients are notified.

I. Eligibility will be based on the following criteria:

- Applicant must either be an employee of a current **NFBA** member company, or they must be related to, or under legal guardianship of a current **NFBA** member company employee.
- Applicant must be currently enrolled or preparing to enroll in undergraduate study at an accredited college, university, technical institute, or trade school.

II. Scholarship(s) will be awarded based on the following criteria:

- Applicant submits a completed application form
- Applicant's field of study could be considered construction industry-related or would ideally support a career path in the Post-frame Construction Industry
- Applicant personally prepares and submits a type-written essay describing in their own words their educational plan and how it relates to the industry. Applicants are encouraged to include any notable academic achievements, participation in extracurricular programs, clubs or service groups, and any special skills or experiences that will prepare them for their educational journey or intended career. Recommended length of essay: 500+ words
- Applicant submits 2 letters of recommendation

The NFBA Foundation Board of Directors shall make selection in mid-May and recipients will be announced and notified in June. Recipients will also be recognized at the Annual NFBA Conference and Expo.

All selections are final. The application form and materials listed above are **due by May 1st** of each calendar year. The NFBA Foundation is not obligated to present scholarships each year. Awards will be presented based on the criteria above and available funds.
