The U.S. fertilizer industry's impact extends to individual states and Congressional districts nationwide.



790 Manufacturing Jobs in Ohio

Nitrogen, phosphorus and potassium are all necessary for plants to grow, and all three are produced in the United States. Phosphorus and potassium are mined from natural deposits and nitrogen fertilizer is produced in a chemical process that relies upon natural gas as a feedstock.



1,703 Retail Jobs in Ohio

Retailers sell fertilizer and related services, including agronomic advice, custom blending, and application, directly to farmers. Whether they are small businesses with one or two locations, or regional and national networks – including farmerowned cooperatives, retailers have a positive economic impact in all 50 states.



\$6.09 billion Economic Impact for Ohio

This includes the direct contribution, supplier contribution and downstream positive impact of the fertilizer industry on the state economy.

Wholesalers and terminal operators serve as a critical link between fertilizer producers and retailers. Companies in this sector offer larger scale purchasing power and storage facilities that help fertilizer retailers manage risk in the national and international fertilizer market.

Fertilizers must be transported from manufacturing plants to wholesale facilities and ultimately retailers. Modes of transport include rail, truck and barge.
