CERTIFICATION & RECERTIFICATION

WHAT

OABA's Grain Grading School, approved by the Ohio Department of Agriculture, provides commodity testers with 2016 certification and recertification opportunities. Sept. 30, 2016 is the renewal deadline.

WHO

All individuals who perform a quality test for the purpose of applying a premium or discount on commodities are required by law to be certified. Those currently certified must either fulfill continuing education requirements, or pass the written exam once every three years to renew their Commodity Tester Certificate.

WHEN & WHERE

Two sessions are offered. Only one is needed for certification.
