The OABA Anhydrous Ammonia Safety Workshops assists **dealers** and their **employees** in complying with the DOT Hazardous Materials Training Requirements for anhydrous ammonia. These workshops also provide an excellent opportunity for dealers to invite their local **emergency personnel** for Anhydrous Ammonia training. All emergency personnel can attend at the member rate.

All employees working with anhydrous ammonia must be trained in general awareness and safety of handling and transporting ammonia. The workshops include experts from both outside and within the industry, along with government regulators. A training video and accompanying workbook is supplemented with real life experiences to provide a robust training program. The work book offers in-depth information and serves as a reference after the workshop is completed. Review questions in the workbook help reinforce the training materials.

Workshop topics include; the properties of ammonia and its safe handling, ammonia equipment, and emergency procedures. The program also features a session on the Federal DOT Rail Regulations for anhydrous ammonia tank car handling and unloading. This session meets the training requirements of Title 49, Chapter 1, Sub-chapter C Part 172, Sub-part H; a must if you handle ammonia by rail.
