Information About Food Safety Modernization Act Compliance

The Food Safety Modernization Act was signed into law on Jan. 4, 2011. We await the final rule for the Current Good **Manufacturing Practices and** Hazard Analysis Risk-Based **Preventive Controls for Food** for Animals of FSMA. The American Feed Industry Association submitted extensive comments about the proposed rule on March 31, 2014, which requested extensive changes to the U.S. Food and Drug Administration's proposed rule. FDA has informed AFIA that we can expect portions of the rule to be submitted for comment this summer that were not included in the first version. Another round of comments will be required.
