



Outstanding Emergency Medicine Resident of the Year Nomination Criteria

The *Emergency Medicine Resident of the Year Award for Ohio Chapter ACEP* recognizes a resident of outstanding merit who demonstrates exemplary clinical promise, leadership, and commitment to their patients and emergency medicine.

The 2016 *Emergency Physician of the Year Award* will be presented at the **Ohio ACEP Emergency Medicine Leadership Forum**, to be held on April 19, 2016 at the Sheraton Columbus Hotel at Capitol Square.

The criteria for the *Emergency Medicine Resident of the Year Award for Ohio Chapter ACEP* are as follows:

1. Current member of the Ohio Chapter ACEP
2. Maintains high professional standards and clinical orientation
3. Demonstrates leadership, serves as a role model, and is respected by peers
4. Exhibits dedication to emergency medicine and patient care
5. Demonstrates commitment to residency education

Other factors that are not required, but would be favorably considered, include commitment to community and/or scholarly activity which has impacted the specialty of emergency medicine.

Please note that individuals who were nominated but not selected may be nominated in subsequent years and any member may be re-nominated any number of times.
