

# Behavioral Health Treatment Insights and Provider Support (BH-TIPS)

Schedule a virtual behavioral health consultation for Ohio pediatric primary care providers

## WHAT IS IT?

Ohio primary care providers can connect with Nationwide Children's Hospital psychiatrists and a care management clinician through a virtual appointment to receive provider-to-provider consultation regarding:

- Screening, assessment and diagnostic clarification
- Principles of medication and non-medication management to fit the specific clinical needs
- Information about available behavioral health resources and linkages in your local community

Our goal is to support primary care providers in the management of children and adolescents with behavioral health concerns in the primary care setting through educational consultation and information about resources in their communities for timely access to care.

## HOW DOES IT WORK?

- Schedule a 15-minute appointment [NationwideChildrens.org/BHTIPS](https://NationwideChildrens.org/BHTIPS)
  - Lunch Hours: Monday through Friday from noon to 2 p.m.
  - Morning Hours: Tuesday and Wednesdays from 7:30 to 8:30 a.m.
- Prior to your appointment, fill out a brief form included in the appointment confirmation email to provide background information and your specific questions for our team
- Join the video conference via Zoom at your appointment time to meet with the psychiatrist and social worker
- Receive summary of consultation and resources discussed during the appointment.
