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<u>3701-76-03</u> **Requirements for registration.**

Any applicant for registration as a sanitarian, as a sanitarian in training, or seeking advancement or reinstatement must meet a minimum set of educational requirements specified in section 4736.08 of the Revised Code.

- (A) Eligibility requirements for an applicant applying for registration shall include the completion of a baccalaureate degree and graduation from an accredited college or university. The applicant must have completed at least forty-five quarter hours or thirty semester hours of coursework in the fields of biology, chemistry, physics, geology, mathematics and/or statistics.
 - (1) Courses approved by the director of health may include more than one field of science as specified above. The applicant may provide a copy of the course syllabus or copy of the course description for review to assist the director in making a determination whether the course is to be approved in accordance with paragraph (A) of this rule.
 - (2) Courses that are remedial or college preparatory in nature shall not be approved or counted toward the minimum educational requirements.
- (B) A foreign educated applicant shall show an educational background deemed by the director of health to be equivalent to at least a baccalaureate degree, including at least forty-five quarter hours or thirty semester hours of coursework in the fields of biology, chemistry, physics, geology, mathematics and/or statistics. The applicant shall submit a credential evaluation for review in lieu of an official transcript. This evaluation must be submitted by the evaluating agency directly to the Ohio department of health on behalf of the applicant. A credential evaluation prepared by an evaluating service reflects only the findings and conclusions of the evaluator and shall not be binding upon the director.
- (C) An applicant must pass an examination conducted by the Ohio department of health. An individual must be registered as a sanitarian in training or be approved as an applicant for registered sanitarian with the Ohio department of health to be eligible to register for the examination.
- (D) An applicant must submit the appropriate application fee. All fees are non-refundable and non-transferable.
 - (1) The sanitarian in training registration application fee shall be eighty dollars.

(2) The advancement application fee shall be eighty dollars.

- (3) The registered sanitarian application fee shall be one hundred sixty-dollars.
- (4) The reinstatement fee shall be two hundred ten-dollars.
- (E) An applicant must submit supporting documentation for their application on forms

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prescribed by the director.
