

#### (Traveling South)

(NOTE: The First and Third St. ramps are closed due to construction.)

- Take I-75 to the Third St./Salem Ave. Exit (Exit 53A)
- TURN LEFT onto Third St.; go approximately 1/4 mile.
- TURN RIGHT onto Perry St. to first stoplight (Fourth St.)
- TURN RIGHT onto Fourth St.
   Entrance to the Lot C
   underground parking garage is on the right side.

## From South

#### (Traveling North)

(NOTE: The First and Third St. ramps are closed due to construction.)

- Take I-75 to Exit 51 (Edwin C. Moses Blvd.)

- TURN RIGHT into the Lot C underground parking garage (approx. 300 feet after passing Perry St.).
