It is my pleasure to submit the Consulting Division report for the year ending June 30, 2017. Since last year's conference, the Consulting Division has received numerous inquiries regarding services available and other requests for assistance.

During the past year, the Consulting Division completed the following fire officer selection processes: Bainbridge Township Fire Chief, Madison Township Fire Chief (Richland Co), Liberty Township Fire Chief (Delaware Co), Jerome Township Fire Chief, Spring Valley Township Fire Chief, village of Grafton Fire Chief, and city of Lebanon Lieutenant. Consulting projects completed over the past year include Falls Township Fire District Feasibility Study, Dresden and Frazeyburg Joint Fire District Feasibility Study, Southwest Hancock County Fire District Feasibility Study, Clay Township Emergency Response District Analysis, Monclova Township Organizational Evaluation, Concord Township Facility Assessment and Station Location Analysis (Lake Co), and Sterling Fire District SOP and Policy Development. We also facilitated the development of a mission and vision for Pleasant Township Fire Department and Strategic Planning for Jefferson Township Fire Department (Madison Co).
