Wright State University Restrictions

- Should you pass away outside the state of Ohio, you will not be eligible to be a donor to our program.
- An autopsy has been performed.

Ohio State University Restrictions

- Contagious disease (HIV, Hepatitis, TB, any hospital acquired disease including MRSA and Clostridium difficile, etc.)
- Extreme emaciation, obesity, or body contractures
- Severe trauma or open wounds (including certain recent surgeries)
- Ascites, edema, or septicemia
- Organs or parts removed at time of death, except eyes
- Current education or research programs are not in need of donors

Cleveland Clinic Statement on their Restrictions

- *“We cannot accept a body when there is severe trauma; the presence of an infectious disease such as hepatitis, HIV/AIDS, Creutzfeldt-Jakob disease, methicillin-resistant Staphylococcus aureus (MRSA), or Clostridium difficile (C. diff); or when there is extreme obesity ([BMI](#) above 39).”*

The University of Toledo Restrictions

- Any individual that has been diagnosed to have a communicable disease is not eligible for this program
- Bodies are not suitable for educational or scientific purposes following an autopsy. If an autopsy is required by the Coroner, the Anatomical Donation Program will still accept my remains, but they may not be used for educational or scientific purposes and will be cremated immediately.

Northeast Ohio Medical University Restrictions

- Northeast Ohio Medical University will not accept a body if a member of the family asserts that he or she intends to go to court in an attempt to break the donor's will in this particular matter.
- No body donations can be accepted if Northeast Ohio Medical University is closed due to national holidays, extreme weather conditions or power outages.
- No body donation can be accepted if the donor dies outside of the state of Ohio.
- No body donation can be accepted if the donor dies outside a 75-mile radius of the University.
- If you choose to donate your organs, the Department of Anatomy and Neurobiology cannot accept your body.

University of Cincinnati Restrictions

Donation of a loved one after death who has not signed a bequeathal form will not be accepted if any of the conditions listed below exist:

- An autopsy has been performed.
- Recent surgery of the chest or abdomen that is not healed.
- Death was caused by certain infectious diseases (in particular, AIDS, infectious hepatitis, Creutzfeldt-Jakob disease, or serious staph infection).
- Any stage IV decubitus (bed sores).
- Presence of gangrene.
- Is in a state of decomposition
- Very obese.
