Article VI - Elections

6 Section 3 - Election of District Representatives to the OOA Board of Trustees. Each 7 district academy shall elect a representative from its membership to serve a three-year 8 term on this association's Board of Trustees. Should the duly elected trustee be unable to 9 attend regular or special board meetings, the academy president shall appoint an alternate 10 trustee who shall attend the meeting. The alternate trustee shall have all voting rights and 11 privileges of the duly elected trustee while serving as a substitute. Districts V (Sandusky), 12 VI (Columbus), IX (Marietta), and XI (Madison), shall elect representatives in 2001, and 13 every three years thereafter. Districts I (Toledo), II (Lima), III (Dayton), and IV 14 (Cincinnati), shall elect representatives in 2002, and every three years thereafter. Districts 15 VII (Cleveland), VIII (Akron Canton), X (Youngstown), and XII (Warren), shall elect 16 representatives in 2000, and every three years thereafter. THE BOARD SHALL 17 ESTABLISH AN INITIAL ELECTION SCHEDULE FOR DISTRICT TRUSTEES SO 18 THAT NO MORE THAN ONE-THIRD OF THE BOARD MEMBERS ARE ELECTED 19 IN A GIVEN YEAR. 20

21 **EXPLANATORY NOTE:** Deletion of the current district names allows the OOA House

22 of Delegates to redistrict without amending the bylaws each time a change is made.
