Northbound on I-75:

Take Third Street Exit #53A. Turn right onto Third Street, right onto Perry Street (second light), right onto Fourth Street (1 block). Turn right into the Lot C Parking Garage under Building 12.

Southbound on I-75:

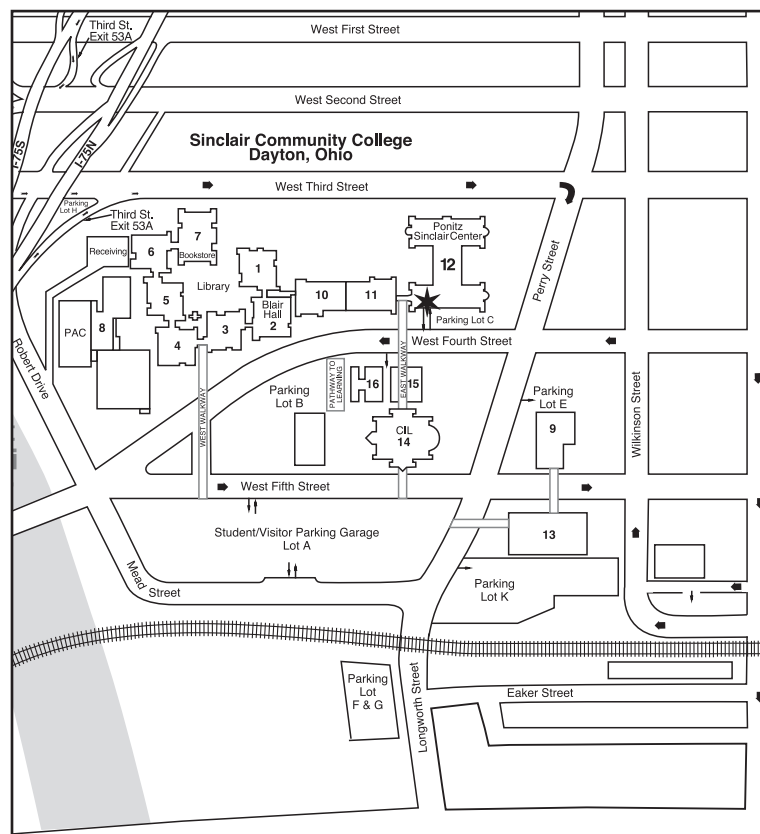
