What is Student Pharmacist Legislative Day?



Student Pharmacist Legislative Day is an advocacy event that allows student pharmacists to meet with legislators to educate them about the value of pharmacists on the health care team. You will learn about the latest legislative issues at the Ohio Statehouse, learn how to effectively communicate those issues, hear from the legislators themselves, and have a chance to individually visit their offices. This program will allow you to become involved in the issues impacting your future pharmacy practice in Ohio. We will discuss new pharmacist-payment models, Medicaid, PBM reform, new laws, scope of practice expansion, and other critical pharmacy issues.
