Venice, Italy ~ Composed of 117 islands in the Venetian Lagoon and held together by a series of canals, Venice is like no other city in the world. Dubrovnik, Croatia ~ Situated at the edge of the Adriatic Sea in the very south of Croatia, Dubrovnik is rich in history and natural beauty. With bays, beaches, steep cliffs and dense woodland areas, Dubrovnik's landscape is unexpected. Although severely damaged in the attack by the Serbs and Montenegrins in the fall of 1991, Dubrovnik's impressive medieval architecture and its beautiful Mediterranean landscape still remain.

Katakolon, Greece ~ Whether you're into sports, history, art, or just lounging by the sea, the charming village of Katakolon, Greece, is a good place to start. From here it's just a quick trip to famed Olympia, birthplace of the ancient Olympics and one-time home to a Wonder of the Ancient World, where Greeks honored the god Zeus. <u>Deposit and Final Payment</u>: A initial deposit of \$500.00 per person is due along with your \$195.00 per person seminar registration fee and optional insurance payment to secure your reservation. A second deposit of \$500.00 is due April 2, 2015. Final payment is due on or before June 17, 2015.
