Why we need this kind of training during residency

- Limited training and experience in ASD during residency

- High demand for evidence based diagnostic evaluation Limited treatment access in the community ASD is the fastest-growing developmental disability • Prevalence in the United States is estimated at 1 in 54 births • Prevalence in U.S. children increased by 119.4 percent from 2000 (1 in 150) to
- 2010 (1 in 68)
- In Ohio, the prevalence of ASD has doubled since 2000

Financial burden and Education cost burden

- Autism Society estimates U.S. annual cost \$90 billion for autism • Lifelong cost care reduced by 2/3 with early diagnosis and intervention • Educating a student with ASD adds more than \$8,600 extra to the average cost of

- Majority of cost are in adult services \$175-196 billion vs \$61-66 billion for children • The U.S. cost of autism over the lifespan is about \$2.4 million for a person with an intellectual disability, and \$1.4 million for a person without intellectual disability
- \$12,000 per neurotypical student
- education after leaving high school

- 2155 ASD related patient encounters were in this clinic in 2020
- 169 Adults patients with suspected ASD seen since initiation in June 2020
- 65 Spanish speaking patients seen in Hispanic MAAC
- 496 Children with suspected ASD seen in this clinic
