## BYLAWS OF THE OHIO STATE MEDICAL ASSOCIATION ORGANIZED MEDICAL STAFF SECTION

## **CHAPTER I – PURPOSE**

- ORGANIZED MEDICAL STAFF SECTION. There shall be a section of the Ohio 1. State Medical Association (OSMA) known as the Organized Medical Staff Section (OMSS) for physicians who are members of the medical staff of an Ohio hospital, other health-care delivery facility or an emerging delivery system registered with the Ohio Department of Health, to be addressed hereafter in these bylaws as organized medical staffs. To be eligible for representation in the OSMA-OMSS, the above entities shall have a medical staff organization, network panel, or group consisting of at least 50% practicing physicians and have a written document that provides a process for the physicians to elect their officers, conduct credentialing and peer
  - A. **PURPOSE.** The purpose of this section is to provide a forum to discuss the needs and concerns of physician members of hospital medical staffs and those who participate in organized medical staffs.

review activities, and provide input to the utilization review and quality

- B. **PARTICIPATION.** Participation in the section's activities shall be open to all members of organized medical staffs who are licensed to practice medicine or surgery or osteopathic medicine and surgery in the state of Ohio.
- C. **PROVISIONAL PARTICIPATION.** Since some organized medical staffs, as defined above, will not have the written documents (bylaws) in place initially, participation shall be open to provisional participation and a representative for a period of one year.

Provisional representatives can testify regarding resolutions. They will be seated with the certified representatives and may have the privilege of the floor during the OSMA-OMSS annual meetings. They

- D. **DELEGATE AND ALTERNATE DELEGATE.** The Delegate and Alternate Delegate shall represent the members of the OMSS at the OSMA House of Delegates.
- TERM. Steering Committee members shall serve a term of two years, 3. beginning at the conclusion of the Annual Meeting at which they were elected or appointed and ending at the conclusion of the Annual Meeting two years hence or until their successors are duly elected and qualified. No member shall serve as Chair for more than three consecutive terms. Any officer originally elected to serve a year or less of an unexpired term shall not be regarded thereby as having served a term. Nothing in these bylaws shall be construed as forbidding later reelection to any office, after an interruption in consecutive service.
  - 4. **VACANCIES.** Any vacancy occurring at an OSMA Annual Meeting shall be filled in accordance with Chapter 4, Section 5 of the OSMA Bylaws. Any vacancy occurring of voting members on the Steering Committee, other than the position of Chair or those occurring at the Annual Meeting of the OSMA House of Delegates, shall be filled by the remaining members of the Steering Committee at their next meeting, by majority vote. The Chair may appoint individuals to fill any vacancy of members.

## **CHAPTER III – BUSINESS MEETING**

- 1. **BUSINESS MEETING.** There shall be a business meeting of members of the Section held on the first day of each Annual Meeting of the OSMA House of Delegates.
  - A. **VOTING REPRESENTATIVES.** The physician members of the organized medical staff may elect a voting representative to the business meeting of the Organized Medical Staff Section. The voting representative must be an OSMA member who is an active and voting member of the organized medical staff. Elected voting representatives to the business meeting shall be certified to the Secretary of the OMSS by an officer of the medical staff of the organized medical staff. The Chair of the OSMA-OMSS may be an
